EDUCATION

Through our IVDU schools (2 high schools and 1 elementary school) unique individualized life and vocational skills training together with curricula of secular and Jewish studies, we prepare students to integrate into the Jewish community and become contributing members of society.



2016 was the IVDU Upper School's LARGEST GRADUATING CLASS with NINE STUDENTS graduating

90% of IVDU Upper School students taking the NY Regents exams passed.



IVDU's **68 STUDENTS** held **52 INTERNSHIPS** in community businesses where they are learning vocational skills.



PROGRAM FOR THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING



The **Hearing Aid Gemach** (free loan society) refurbished **22 PAIRS OF HEARING AIDS** and lent out **30 PAIRS** to those who could not afford to purchase their own.

Our Way hosted eight **social and learning programs** for over **200 PEOPLE** who are deaf or hard of hearing.

650 COMMUNITIES on six continents used Yachad's **Purim Megillah Power Point** to ensure that those with hearing impairments were able to follow along and celebrate together.



CLINICAL & FAMILY SERVICES

Yachad works with individuals with a wide range of disabilities including but not limited to cognitive, developmental and physical challenges.



SOCIAL SKILLS COURSES are held in Detroit, Florida, Israel, Los Angeles, New England, New York, New Jersey, and Toronto.

Yachad's 30th Annual Northeast Family Shabbaton hosted 78 FAMILIES

for a weekend of support, networking, learning, and building community.



COMMUNITY AWARENESS

Yachad is leading the Jewish community; helping our schools and synagogues become more inclusive. As a founding member of Hineinu, Yachad partners with the Conservative, Reform, Reconstructionist, and Chabad movements to share best practices in inclusion.

As a part of NAIM **72** synagogues participated in a **SHABBAT B'YACHAD** by dedicating one Shabbat to talking and learning about inclusion.



5,035 students had the opportunity to "walk in someone else's shoes" through **68 SENSITIVITY TRAINING** sessions offered by Yachad this year. **438** teachers and youth leaders participate in specialized sensitivity trainings to help them create inclusive environments.



Yachad has educated **700 TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS** about strategies for **facilitating inclusion in the mainstream classroom**, giving them the tools they need to support students with learning differences.



Following Yachad's 8th Grade Leadership Shabbaton, 94.4% of attendees demonstrated knowledge of what inclusion means.

ADULT & VOCATIONAL SERVICES

125 people attended the first ever PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAY for Individuals with Disabilities

The DAY HABILITATION AND VOCATIONAL programs host over 15 social skills training groups per week.



YACHAD GIFTS sold **7,000** gift baskets, up 17% from last year. **4,500** of these baskets were sold for **Purim**.



Yachad Gifts had **45** people in the **VOCATIONAL TRAINING** program, **20** of whom come from other agencies looking for training opportunities.

ISRAEL

BIRTHRIGHT - Yachad is the go to Birthright provider offering trips for people with disabilities. This year 47 PARTICIPANTS connected with Israel through Yachad's Birthright trips. 10 PARTICIPANTS celebrated their Bar/Bat Mitzvah on Yachad Birthright.



ISRAEL CHAPTER

490 pizza pies were inclusively made and donated to IDF soldiers through the PIZZAS-4-SOLDIERS campaign.

Yachad hosted the first ever **FAMILY SHABBATON** in Israel – serving **35** families.

SUMMER

Yachad together with mainstream Jewish camps enable campers with disabilities to attend camp with extra support through a shadow in a typical bunk or by creating a Yachad bunk that participates in all camp activities. Adults with disabilities have the opportunity to work at camp through Yachad's Vocational Programs.



82% of parents reported that their camper was **FULLY INCLUDED** in the camp community.



Parents reported that Campers came home with **INCREASED** development in **SOCIAL SKILLS**, daily living skills, INDEPENDENCE, and communication.



496 campers participated in one of Yachad's 23 SUMMER PROGRAMS with campers from three countries, 18 states and 491 cities around the world.

91 ADULTS with disabilities attended camp through our VOCATIONAL WORKERS **PROGRAM**. They held positions throughout the camps in departments such as sports, canteen, dining, infirmary, and more.



44% of campers received scholarships from Yachad to attend a summer program.



Yachad's inclusive traveling summer program in Israel for young adults with and without disabilities.

High school aged participants joined Yad B'yad from 162 CITIES across the US and Canada.

17 of this summer's Yad B'yad staff were former Yad B'yad participants.

DEAR FRIENDS

"Why doesn't anyone want to be my friend?" A heart breaking question that no parent should ever have to answer for their child, but for many raising a child with a disability, this question is all too real.

For the past 33 years, Yachad has worked to promote the inclusion of individuals with disabilities into all aspects of Jewish communal life. With your help, we have taken these individuals out of the shadows and created meaningful opportunities for them to be included in schools, synagogues, camps and neighborhood and community events.

This year alone, your generous support enabled 496 campers to attend a Jewish summer camp with their typically developing peers, 700 teachers to receive training on including learners with disabilities in their classrooms, 45 adults with disabilities to receive vocational training through Yachad Gifts, and so much more.

Without you, we would never have been able to accomplish so much. But the work is far from complete. Too many kids, teens and adults with special needs are still asking why they don't have friends, or a Jewish education, or a job. Together we can continue to educate communities, provide inclusive opportunities and facilitate friendships.


